Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am pleased to present you with the Waldron Mercy Academy 2021-2022 Health & Safety Plan.

This plan was developed with our COVID-19 medical taskforce and guidance from national and local health authorities. Please be advised that many of the same mitigation measures from last year will be in place, including the installed air purifiers in each room, and desk shields inside when masks are off (eating snack/lunch).

Some other highlights of the plan are:

- In-person learning for all students.
- Indoor masking for all, regardless of vaccination status.
- Masks may be solid colors or patterned and void of any messaging.
- All classrooms seat students 3 feet apart with desks facing the same direction.
- All staff and students who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 must supply a physical or digital copy of their vaccination card to our nurses, [Candace Flowers, RN](#), and [Joanne Ferdinand, RN](#).
- Water fountains will remain turned off but bottle fillers will be available.
- Daily RUVNA health checks for all students and staff will continue (New families - you will automatically be texted and emailed a link to the health check each morning).
- Hand sanitizer will be available at entrances, in hallways, in classrooms, and in other high traffic areas throughout the school.
- Until the cafeteria opens, students choosing to order lunch from our cafeteria will receive individual meals (boxed lunches) delivered to their classrooms.
- Once the cafeteria opens, an evaluation will be made based on the current Covid-19 conditions as to the number of students that will use the seating space at one time.
- We are not requiring vaccinations at this time for any individuals, but we strongly recommend that all members of the WMA community who are eligible receive a vaccination against COVID-19.

Please read the attached plan carefully for all details, with the understanding that the plans and policies are subject to change in accordance with guidance from the CDC, MontCo OPH, the CHOP Policy Lab, and in consideration of local and community conditions.

Uniforms

As we return to our [full uniform policy](#), we understand that due to supply chain issues, many people are having challenges obtaining uniform pieces. Please do not worry! We know we are all doing the best we can and we will use the month of September to work through these challenges together. Our used uniform clothesline will be available today from 2:30-3:30 p.m. during the Classroom Meet and Greet as well as at the Back to School Picnic on 9/12. Khaki shorts and skirts can be purchased at any store and navy blue non-branded golf shirts from any retailer can also be worn until logo gear becomes available.
